

**History**

The children will be learning about the Great Fire of London, an event beyond living memory. We will look at different types of sources including beginning to understand reliability and that different people may have different accounts of events. The children will be developing their understanding of chronology and placing key events on a timeline.

**Science**

Throughout Autumn term, we will be learning about materials, including the names and properties of different materials to investigate changes and how properties of make them appropriate to be used for specific tasks. The children will be exploring materials and their properties practically through experimentation, demonstrating their skills to work scientifically.

**Art**

During Art lessons, the children will focussing on drawing and the minimalist artwork of Federico Babina. We will be experimenting with pen and crayon, before creating their own colourful building in the style using oil pastels, scraping tools on card.

**Is an accident ever truly blameless?**

**Hook** – we will have a themed day: discussing our big question, introducing vocabulary and sticky knowledge, learning about what London was like in past and creating a collaborative display including artwork in mixed media of a houses and a timeline of events we have covered already.



**Maths**

In Autumn 1, the will be focussing on place value. Through this they will be consolidating and further developing their understanding of number. The children will all look at representing numbers in different ways as well as comparing and ordering numbers. Following this we will begin our unit on addition and subtraction which will continued in Autumn 2 Each week the children have an arithmetic day, wherein they practice a variety of number sentences.

**English**

The children will begin the term by looking at the text 'Rapunzel' by Bethan Woolvin. During our first unit on narrative writing, we will familiarise ourselves with the text before looking at the features, then planning and writing our own narrative. After this we will write a set of instructions for 'How to catch a witch' based on the 'Rapunzel' text. The children will have daily Read, Write Inc. phonics session as well as discrete reading lessons, weekly spelling sessions and daily handwriting sessions.

**PE**

This term we will be focussing on team game skills through Outdoor Adventurous Activities with a sports coach. The children will also be participating PE lessons with their class teacher focussing on basic movement skills.

**RE**

In RE, we will be learning about Jewish stories including how and why some stories are important in religions.

**Music**

This term we will be using our voices creatively to make different sounds, recognising the difference in pitch between their singing and spoken voice through songs, chants and rhymes.

**Learning for Life**

Through our Learning for Life sessions, the children will be learning about themselves and their relationships.

**Computing**

In Computing, the children will be learning about online safety, exploring Purple Mash and algorithms through Maze explorers.
