# ALL STARS U11 TOURNAMENT

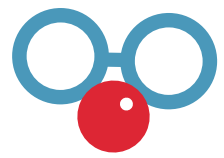
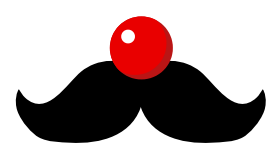
