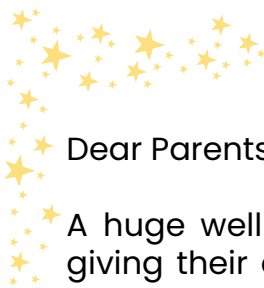

Have a relaxing weekend.

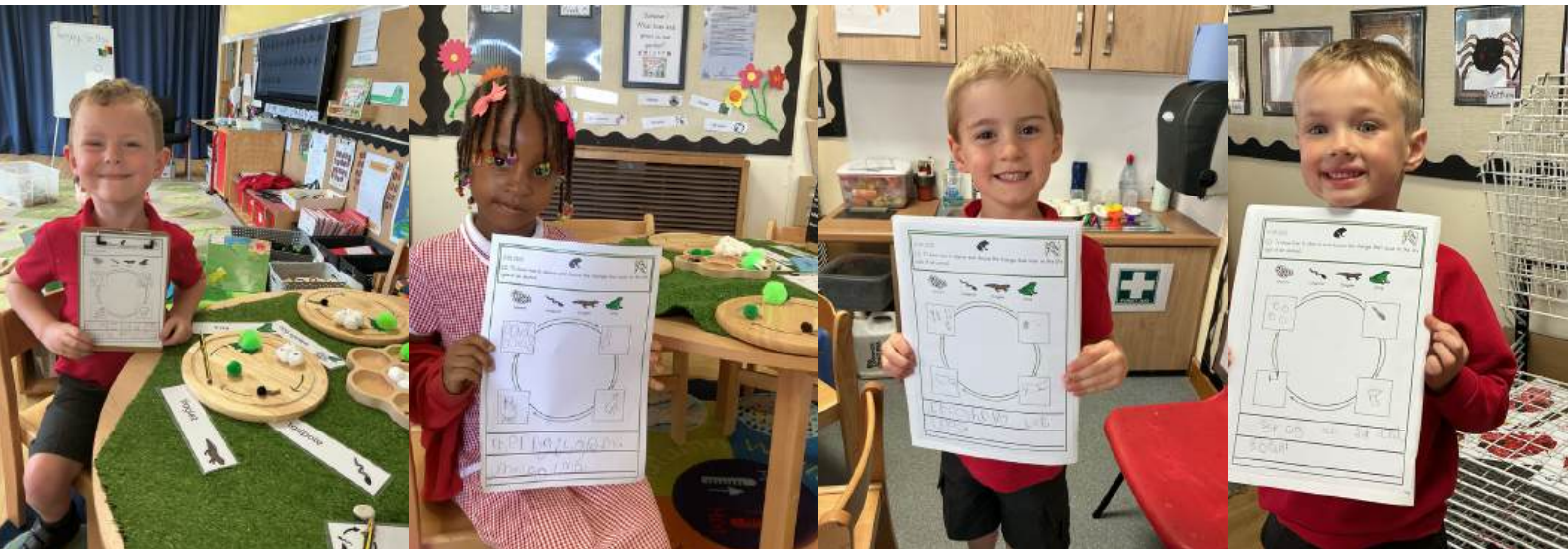
