## Foundation

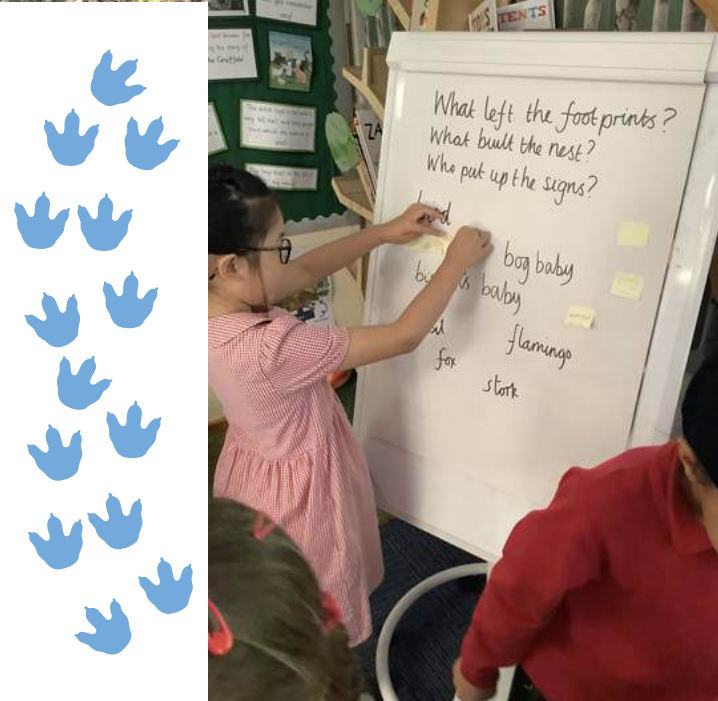
