

History

The children will be learning about the Ancient Egyptian and Greek civilisations through our history curriculum. We will learn about when these civilisations took place and know how to ask questions about artefacts / sources of information to question the validity and reliability of these.

They will know how to learn more about a historical period through comparing both primary and secondary sources.

Maths

In Autumn , the children will learning about place value and the main four operations.

They will also be focussing on learning their times tables and becoming fluent up to 12x12.

Music

We will be listening to and appreciating music from different periods of time. We will begin with the baroque period and move on to listen to classical and modern day music. We will then focus on our singing and performing.

RE

In RE, we are learning about inspirational people from the past.

After half term, we will focus on Hinduism and learn about Hindu festivals.

What can we learn about belief, power and culture in ancient civilisations?

Hook day– On the first day back we will be immersing ourselves in all things Ancient Egypt. We will learn about hieroglyphics and how to write like the Ancient Egyptians. We will also learn about Pharaohs and create our own headdresses.

During the second half term, we will be having an Ancient Greece experience day to deepen our knowledge and understanding of Ancient Greece,.



Art and D&T

In Art, the children will be focussing on drawing. They will create a final piece inspired by Minty Sainsbury with a mixed media approach.

In D&T, the children will create a Greek salad. They will design, create and evaluate their salad to meet their design criteria. We will be tasting Greek food, looking at food packaging and seeing if we can create something that looks and tastes good.

English

The children will begin by looking at the story 'The Time-Slip Scarab'. We will use this to write our own narratives applying the features that we have learnt.

We will then write a diary recount inspired by the diary of an archaeologist exploring Ancient Egypt.

After half term, we will be writing a Greek myth.

We will then write a non-chronological report about our own mythical creatures that we create.

PE

This term we will be learning the skills of Outdoor Adventurous Activities and athletics.

With TB sports they are learning how to play tag rugby and then will move on to learn the skills of gymnastics.

Science

Throughout Autumn, we will be learning about states of matter. We will learn how to compare and group materials together according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases. Also, we will look the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature. We will be conducting experiments and working scientifically to understand these key concepts.

Learning for Life

Through our Learning for Life sessions, we will be learning about 'Me and my Relationships' and 'Valuing Difference'.

Computing

In Computing, the children will be learning about online safety and the importance of staying safe online. They will also learn how to create a program which accomplishes a specific goal in a simulated environment using coding.
