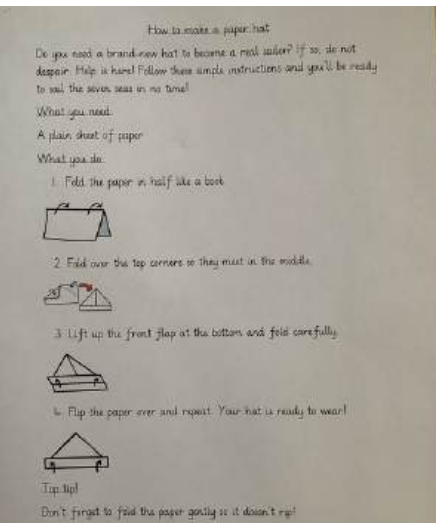
THIS WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS

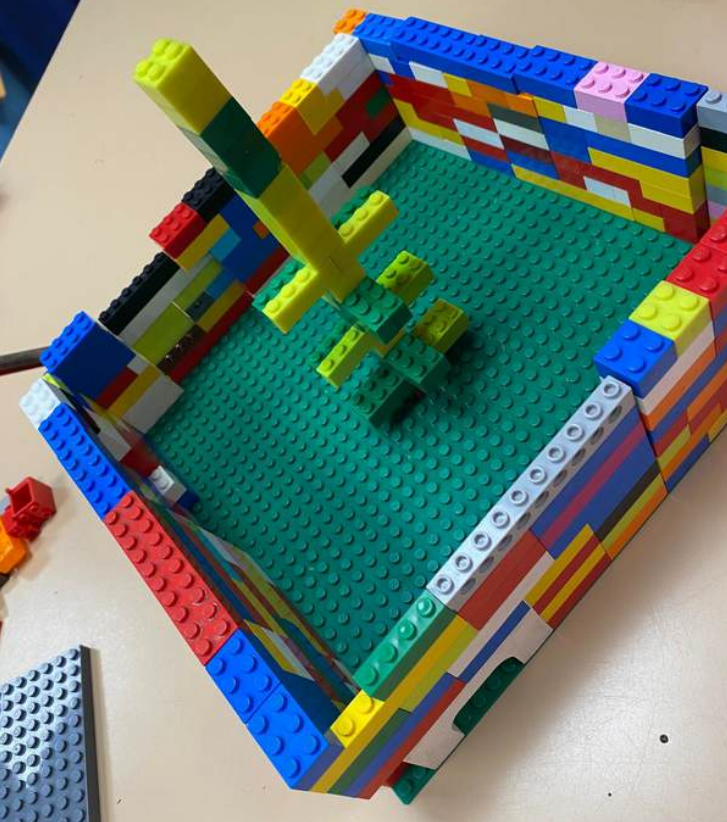
