Be Greythorn Smart! -School Uniform

Greythorn school uniform is a red school sweatshirt/jumper/cardigan (no hoodies), a red polo shirt (white is acceptable until September 2025), dark grey trousers, dark grey skirt, dark grey shorts (**not black**), plain black shoes, grey or white socks, grey or red tights. Black school shoes or boots to be worn not trainers. The only jewellery that can be worn are small stud earrings are allowed (no drop earrings or large oversized earrings). Your child must be able to remove them for PE lessons. Pupils with long hair need to have a hair bobble to tie it back for PE days. No bracelets or necklaces to be worn in school. No smart watches to be worn. Hair to be tied back for PE. Please ensure that your child/ren are not wearing nail varnish to school.
